Create a Linked In Profile:

1. Go to LinkedIn.com
2. In the Blue box "**Join Linked In Today**", Type your name, email and choose a password.
3. Click green "**Join**" Now button.
4. You'll get a message that your account has been created, continue filling in your information.
5. Click blue **Enter** Linked In button.
6. You must confirm your email address, check your email for a confirmation message.
7. On the left panel of the screen, you'll see an icon for groups, click that and there is a groups directory on the right hand side of the screen. Click the gold "**find a group**" button.
8. On the left side of the screen, Search Groups by entering the name of the group in the key word box.
9. Click Blue **Search** button.
10. Choose the group you wish to join by clicking "Join this Group" - To join more than one group - repeat process at step 7.
11. You will see a group summary on the right side of the screen showing all the groups you have joined - if you don't see your group name you are not yet a member of that group.
12. If you receive an invitation to join a group, please click "Join the Group" not reply to the person.
13. For Chamber Marketplace, you will get a prompt asking you to check a box to agree to receive postings from other members. You MUST check this box in order to be able to post.
